Our children's safety and security is of primary importance. Children should be supervised at all times, therefore they should **arrive no sooner than 15 minutes before their class time** and will gather in Dolan Hall. They should be **picked up within 15 minutes after their class time**. All students Kindergarten-6th Grade must be dropped off and picked up at covered awning between the church and Dolan Hall. The children will not be allowed to walk to/from circle drive in front of the church or to/from the parking lot on the south side of the church without an escort. It is important that we have your support in this policy.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

All students must show respect in their behavior, care of the facility and manner of dress. Cell phones must be turned off at all times, or will be confiscated until the end of class. Students must not disrupt the teaching process for their Catechist (Teacher), or the learning process for fellow students through disruptive or non-cooperative behavior. Students must exhibit Christian concern for others by avoiding ostracizing behavior such as bullying or gossiping. If a student commits an infraction of these policies, he or she will be sent to the Religious Ed Office and depending on the event, may or may not be sent back to class that evening. For repeated offenses, the Parent/Guardian will be asked to discuss appropriate interventions, which could include having the Parent/Guardian attend class with the student until behavior is resolved. It is important that we have your support in this policy.

INTERNET VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY:

To help our students express their faith to the community, and to help the community understand the options for faith formation for young people at St. John Bosco, occasionally pictures or videos of our students' activities may be published to our website or other forum. It is important that we have your permission.

CIRCLE OF GRACE LESSONS:

The Diocese mandates that we conduct Safe Environment Education for Catechists, Volunteers, Parents, and Students. This education promotes a deeper understanding of the human person as graced and loved by God, and not to be harmed or neglected in any way. Students are taught each year, in an age appropriate way, the basic vocabulary and understanding of what it means to guard one's own well-being and also the well-being of those around them. They are taught to recognize abuse in all its forms, and how to address it if it is seen. While Circle of Grace is not intended to intrude on personal modesty boundaries, sometimes the subject matter brings forth sincere questions from the students. The Catechist either responds accurately to the questions, or if appropriate, refers the question to the Parent. It is important that we have your permission for these lessons to be taught to your child.
