We pray all of you are healthy and safe as this year begins with continued hurricane recovery and Covid-19. Please know we acknowledge that you are the main teacher of your child's catholic faith. We are here to assist you. Please register your child for which ever grade they are in school. Sacramental preparation will continue to be a priority.

The Knights of Columbus have generously agreed to allow the use of their building for CCD classes. Classes being held in two locations will create new challenges.

This year all grades may register for In-Person Classes or for homeschool bookwork except for sacramental years. Classes will be held in the Church and at the KC Hall on Wednesdays. We will start the new year off with Mass for all students, parents, and teachers on Wednesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm (the time may change.) Classes will start on Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> at the following times and locations.

The calendar will follow the same schedule as Calcasieu Parish Schools. Dates for meetings, retreats, and special events for sacramental preparation will be scheduled and announced as the year progresses.

Registration fees remain \$25/child – maximum of \$50/family. As usual please do not let financial reasons stop you from registering your children. Also, register your child for the same grade as school regardless of last year's completion of CCD curriculum.

St. John Bosco will follow guidelines and mandates from the Bishop's Office, the CDC, government officials, and local schools including temperature checks and facemask protocol for students and adults as required.
