

The Feast Day of St. John Bosco is this Friday, January 31. We will have Mass in the main church to celebrate our patron saint, St. John Bosco. Born in 1815 and died in 1888, St. John Bosco is noted for caring for the youth. In 1876, St. John Bosco founded a movement of laity, the Association of Salesian Cooperators, with educational missions to the poor. In 1875, he began to publish the *Salesian Bulletin*, which continues to be published. St. John Bosco was canonized in 1934.
