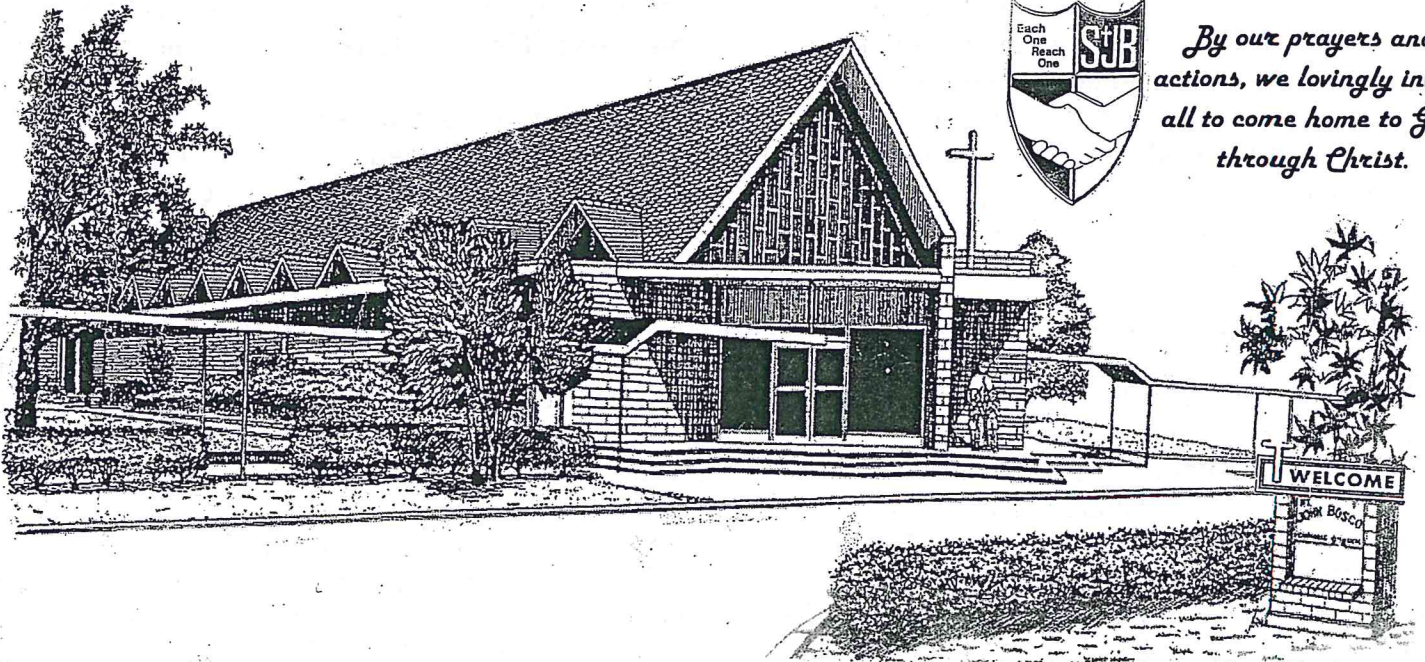

On this fortieth day after Christmas, we find yet another reason to celebrate the great incarnation of Jesus Christ our Lord. This day was traditionally the end of a much longer Christmas season than what we currently observe, and in the midst of continuing winter darkness, it is good to recall yet again the true Light of the World: the Presentation of the Lord.

All women were considered unclean after the childbirth and had to present themselves after forty days at the temple for purification. Sinless, yet obedient to the law, Mary conformed. In time, the name became Presentation of the Lord. The significance of the feast relates to two (2) important elders of the Jewish temple: Anna and Simeon. Upon seeing Jesus, Simeon proclaims how he waited his whole life to meet the Messiah; and it is Jesus.
