

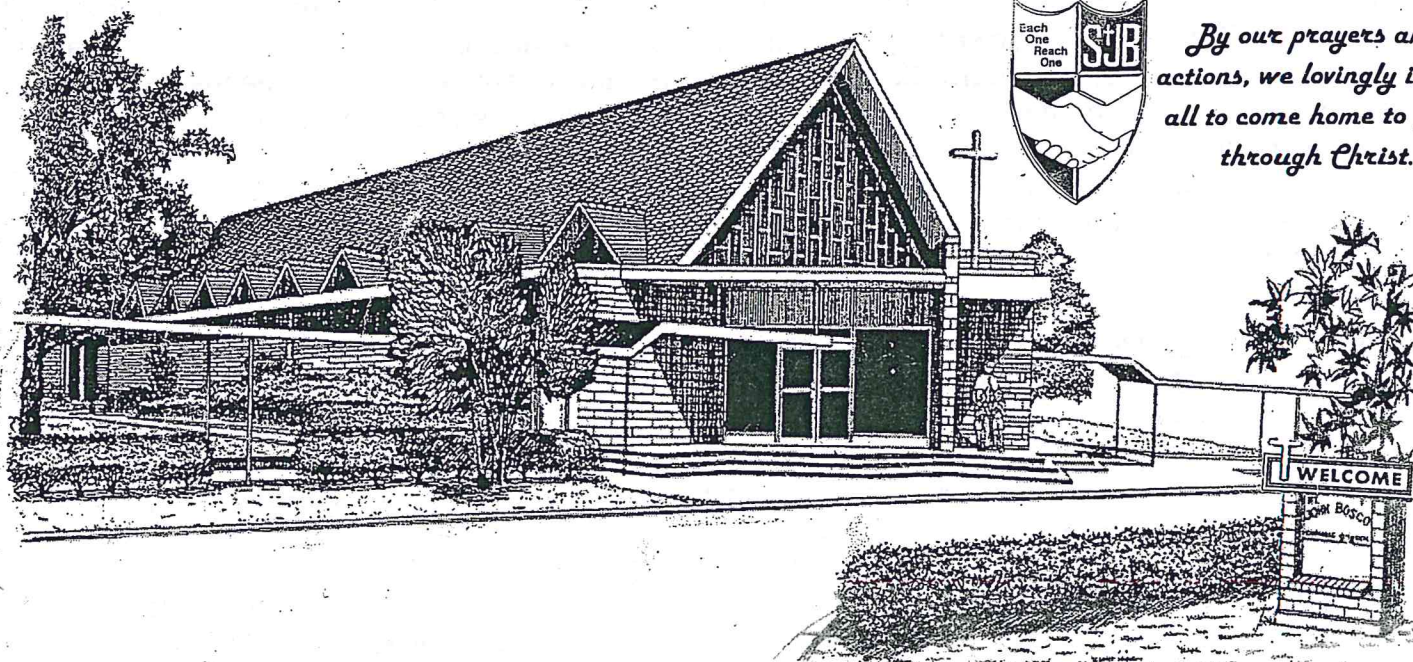

Sometimes we hear people say that Christianity is all fine and good, but people need to be careful not to allow themselves to go overboard about it. It's almost as though Christianity were like salt: it should be used sparingly. Otherwise, a follower of Jesus might become a fanatic, and we certainly don't want to be called a fanatic! Recently, we heard the eight Beatitudes, the opening section of Jesus' sermon on the Mount. Last Sunday, we heard Jesus describe his disciples as the salt of the earth and a light set on a lamp stand. In today's Gospel, Jesus uses even more concrete language.

This is where people are often tempted to soften Jesus' message to avoid radical changes in their lives. Jesus is either at the core of who we are, or in fact, He really touches nothing. We must live in such a way that our life would not make sense if God did not exist.

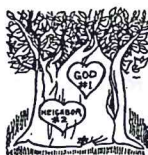
