### Reflection - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time...

The two widows we meet today are faces of Christ, particularly of the ultimate sacrifice He will make. These widows had no "safety net" to rely on, from either government assistance or institutional programs. Without an income or social standing, they were left to rely on the generosity of others. Yet, it was their own generosity that made them models of Jesus' self-sacrifice. Each willingly gives her only asset, "her whole livelihood" to the Lord (Mk. 12:44.) In our acquisitive culture, in which society judges us by our possessions, we are always encouraged to buy the newest and latest, the hottest, giving from our want is countercultural, even crazy.

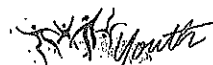

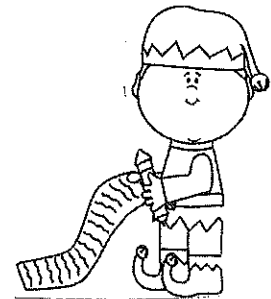
