### Reflection—3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the longer form of the Second Reading, St. Paul builds his analogy of the body, ending by pointing out that “if one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it.” We are all members of the Body of Christ, of the “one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.” If one of us suffers, the entire Church suffers. Many suffer from chronic illness; or poverty, or racism, or emotional trauma, or physical limitations. Many are not able to reach their full potential. In an even wider sense, since we are all children of God, the human family is united as one as well. And so we are called to care for the least of our brothers and sisters, be they next door or at the other end of the world.

**Prayer for Priests...** *Oh, Jesus, Eternal Father, look down with love upon Thy priests. Fill them with burning zeal for the conversion of sinners. Keep them within the shelter of Thy Sacred Heart. Keep unstained their anointed hands which daily touch Thy Sacred Body. Keep unsullied their purple lips with Thy Precious Blood. Keep pure and unearthy thier hearts sealed with the sublime marks of Thy glorious Priesthood. Let Thy holy love protect them from the world's contagion. Bless their labors with abundant fruit, and may the souls to whom they minister on earth be one day their joy and consolation in heaven. Amen.*

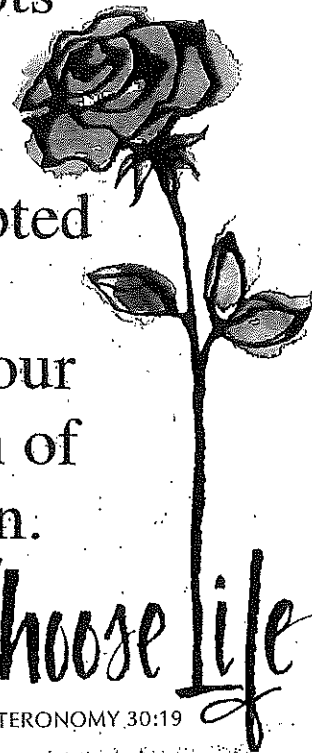
