## Reflection—Palm Sunday

From the start, Jesus leaves us amazed.



We pass from the joy of welcoming Jesus as He enters Jerusalem to the sorrow of watching Him condemned to death and then crucified. His people give Him a solemn welcome, yet He enters Jerusalem on a lowly colt. His people expect a powerful liberator at Passover, yet He comes to bring the Passover to fulfillment by sacrificing himself. His people are hoping to triumph over the Romans by the sword, but Jesus comes to celebrate God's triumph through the cross. And what is amazing about the Lord and His Passover? It is the fact that He achieves glory through humiliation, and by accepting suffering and death. Oh, how He loves you and me!

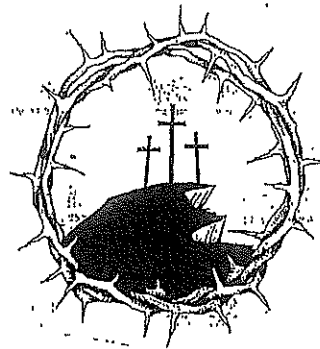
