Fourth Sunday of Easter...

Every Sunday Jesus draws us here, as a shepherd draws his flock. "My sheep hear my voice and they follow Me."



Jesus loves his flock, suffering and dying for us. He feeds his flock with his own Body and Blood. And He provides for his flock by sending us the Holy Spirit.

And how appropriate that we hear this Gospel passage on Mother's Day. Jesus compares himself to a shepherd, guiding and protecting us. He promises the sheep of his flock that He will forever hold them securely in his hand. How fortunate we are who have or had mothers who have guided us, protected us, loved us, and held us, who have treated us with the tender care of the Good Shepherd.
