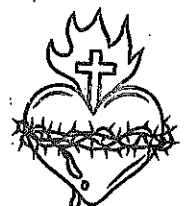

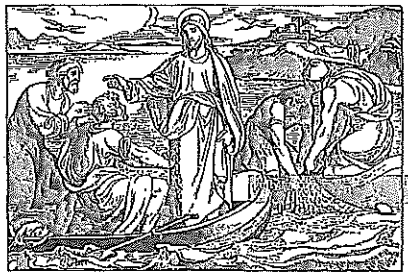

Reflection for the 12th Sunday

The Gospel invites us to a deep level of trust in our God. God loves us and cares for us always and will not let us perish. We don't always understand the ways of God-and that should never surprise us. God sees all and knows all and our vision and knowledge is so restricted!

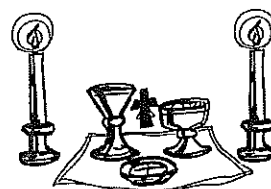
