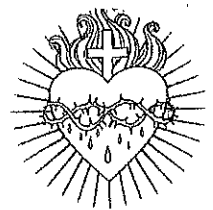

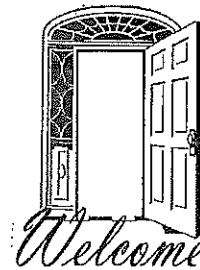

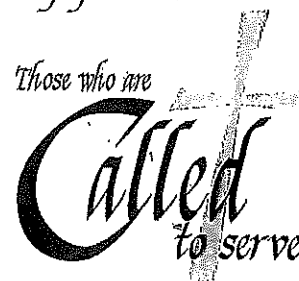


We welcome our new members of St. John Bosco. We ask that you would drop by the office and fill out a registration form. Our office is in the rectory, the house behind the church.
