*Reflection for the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Today's Readings are a wonderful antidote to our culture's attitude that the accumulation of material wealth should be everyone's goal. "Vanities of vanities," this notion is, for what guarantee is there that you will ever be able to enjoy all the wealth you worked for? Greed is idolatry, Paul says in the next Reading; instead seek what is above. After all, Jesus points out in the Gospel, the rich man is a fool for thinking he can control the rest of his life through wealth.

It is possible to have wealth and still have a life of poverty if one doesn't become a slave to one's riches. But the more we possess, the more we want to possess, and then the heart closes itself off to the one true treasure: the love of God and neighbor.
