Reflection - 30th Sunday in Ordinary Time...

A contrast can be made with last Sunday's Gospel. Jesus asks virtually the same question to Bartimaeus that he asked James and John. "What do you wish/want Me to do for you?" The apostles, not seeing what they were asking for, ask for glory, something Jesus is neither able or willing to give; the blind man, seeing who Jesus truly is, asks to be made whole, exactly what Jesus can and will give. One last contrast: Bartimaeus' physical sight was impaired, but his spiritual sight was clear. Even when Jesus cures him, he threw away his cloak - essential for his occupation - and immediately after he was cured, he followed Jesus on the way.

Prayer of St. Therese of the Child Jesus for Priests

O Jesus, I pray for your faithful and fervent priests; for your unfaithful and tepid priests; for your priests laboring at home or abroad; for your tempted priests; for your young priests; for your lonely and desolate priests; for your dying priests; for the souls of your priests in purgatory.

But above all, I recommend to You the priests dearest to me; the priest who baptized me; the priests who absolved my sins; the priests at whose Masses I assisted and who give me your Body and Blood; the priests who taught and instructed me.

Oh Jesus, keep them close to your heart, and bless them abundantly in time and in eternity. Amen.

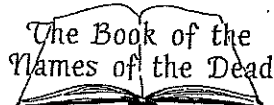
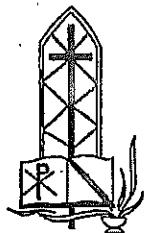
