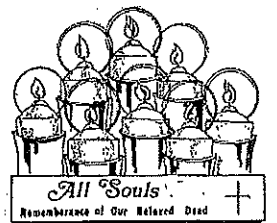

Reflection - 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time...

Monday (Nov. 1) is *All Saints Day* (also known as All Hallows' Day or Halloween). It is a feast day celebrated for believers to remember all saints and martyrs, known and unknown, throughout Christian history.

Tuesday (Nov. 2) is *All Souls Day* when we remember those who have died. The prayers appointed for that day remind us that we are joined with the Communion of Saints, that great group of Christians who have finished their earthly life and with who we share the hope of Resurrection from the dead. It is good to pray for those who have died.

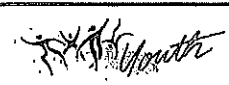

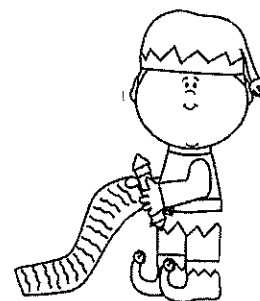
