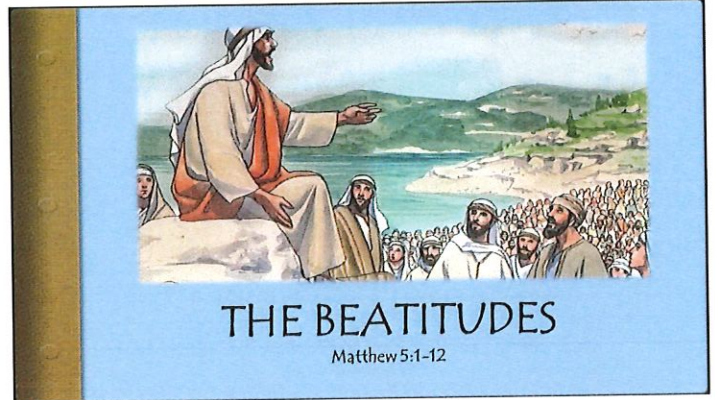

In today's Gospel, Jesus is still at the beginning of his ministry as He gathers around Himself those who are curious and those who are seeking. He gives them a mission statement for the Kingdom of God. We all know and love the Beatitudes, which can be likened to a job description for a follower of Christ.
