Reflection for the 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The parable Jesus tells in today's Gospel is a curious one, whose lessons are not as obvious as, say, the parables of the good Samaritan or the prodigal son. Perhaps one lesson is that material wealth can be used in a prudent way to provide for those in need. The dishonest, self-centered steward used his position prudently to ensure he could maintain his comfortable lifestyle after losing his job. As unselfish stewards of all God's gifts, we can take what we have and prudently use it to serve others. Then when our material wealth fails, as all material goods eventually will, we can hope to be "welcomed into eternal dwellings."

On this Catechetical Sunday, let us be reminded that Jesus, our Teacher, continually teaches us the way to eternal dwellings.
