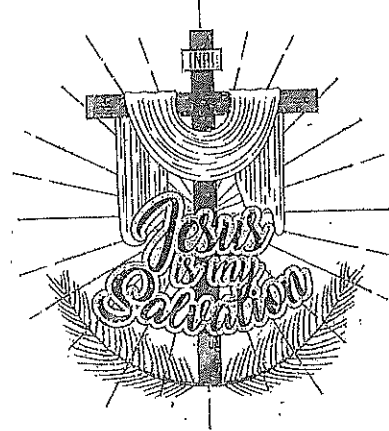

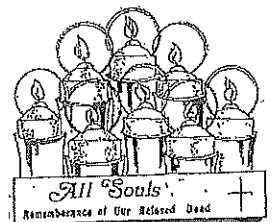

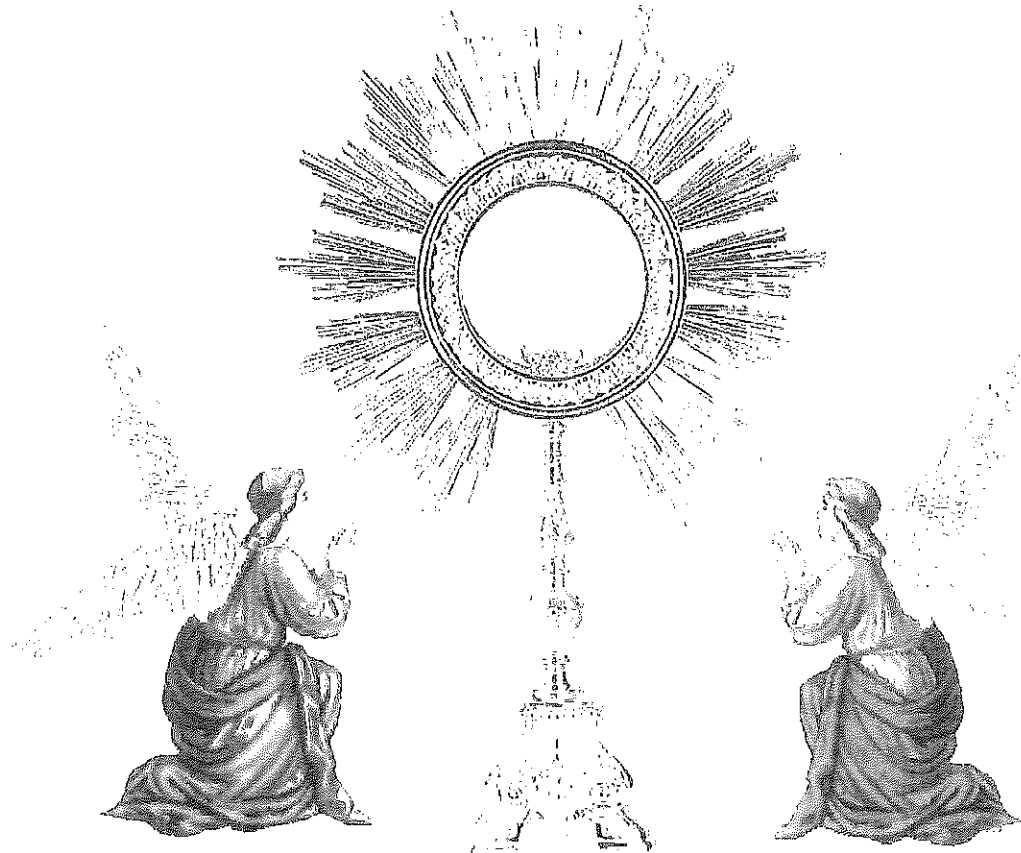
Clothes Drive...
