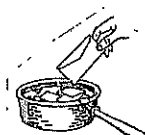

Reflection—2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

According to John, it was three days after his Baptism that Jesus attended the wedding at Cana. In the presence of his newly called disciples, He transformed the water into wine. At the Last Supper, in the presence of his disciples, He changed the wine into his Blood. Today, at this Eucharistic feast, gathered with fellow disciples and in the presence of the Lord, once again the wine is transformed into his blood.

In partaking in the Eucharistic, we are transformed by Christ's Body and Blood. No matter how we feel about ourselves, we are not forsaken or desolate. We are God's children, each a cause for God's rejoicing, continually transformed and renewed in holiness as Christians.

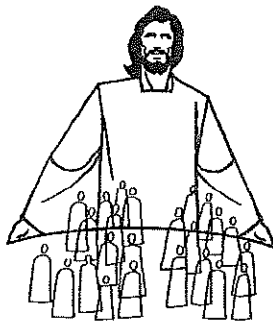


CCD classes continue on Wednesdays:
