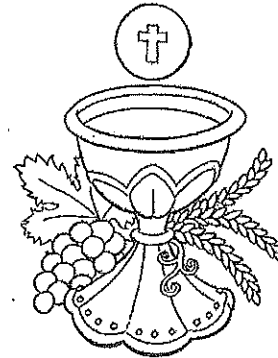

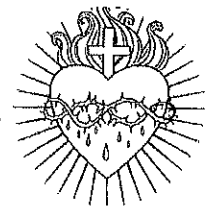

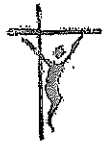

"Do this in memory of Me," Jesus says twice at the Last Supper. He offers his Precious Body and Blood for us all and asks that we do the same in his memory. We, the Church, are the body of Christ. What may seem impossible to provide on a huge scale—food for the hungry, shelter for the homeless, welcome for the stranger, comfort for the sorrowing, justice for the oppressed, mercy for the sinful—can become a reality through the body of Christ. It is up to us, having received Christ's Body in this holy sacrament, to share this gift in abundance to those in need.

So today, nearly two thousand years after the first time his followers did, we celebrate the Eucharist, remembering that Jesus Christ offered his Body and Blood to redeem us from sin, giving his earthly life to give us heavenly life.
