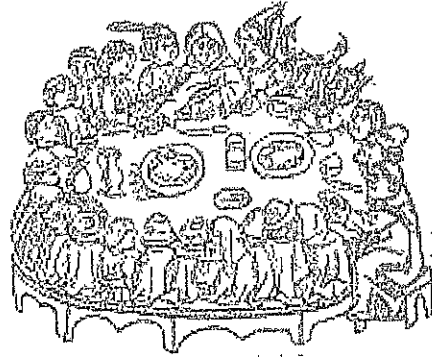

Reflection for the 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

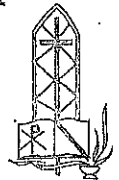

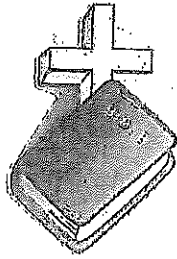
