

Reflection for the 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

We always need to be prepared to meet our Lord as our judge. Let us always remember "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will enter his house and dine with him and he with Me." Since no one is sure about the time and circumstance of his or her death, we must be ever prepared—by talking to Him and listening to Him in Bible readings, by asking guidance of the Holy Spirit every day, by recharging our spiritual batteries through prayer, Masses, Holy Communion, and by getting reconciled with God each day.

We hear in the readings today that the road to redemption is difficult; our own encounters with sin and evil can be divisive. Let us pray for each other to meet our Lord in everyday activities, and to always be prepared to meet Him.

# The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

August 15, 2022

Masses at 8am and 6pm.

Mary did not suffer from original sun, but was conceived full of grace. Angel Gabriel greeted Mary with "Hail, full of grace." And because Mary was conceived without sin, we can see the Immaculate Conception as a basis for understanding Mary's Assumption. The Church teaches that Mary was taken to Heaven when her earthly life was over. Many theologians and saints throughout the centuries, have affirmed that Mary experienced death—not as a penalty of death for sin, but in conformity to her son who suffered death on our behalf.
